<u>Institutional Framework</u>


- **High Power Committee (HPC)** formed under chairmanship of Hon. CS to review the progress of SDGs and provide directives for future improvement
- GSIDS is a state nodal SDGs implementing agency under GAD planning
 - State SDGs Cell:
 - To analyse strategies and plans of the present schemes for achieving state SDGs 2030 road map.
 - Re-orientation of schemes/programmes to align with the strategies and plan of action of SDG 2030 road map.
 - Appointment of Consulting agency: Darashaw & Co. Pvt Ltd (April 2018 March 2019) to provide professional support (Development of Online Dashboard & Monitoring)
- SDGs Steering Committee (SSC) to steer implementation of programmes in context to SDGs





Implementation Framework

- Government of Gujarat has prepared Gujarat Sustainable Vision 2030 document July 2018.
- All the State Govt. schemes / Programmes (700 +) including **Centrally Sponsored Schemes have been mapped with the Sustainable Development Goals**
- Outcome Budget was initiated in Gujarat since 2017-18: Vision to link the budgetary provisions to the Development outcomes


- Development of a dynamic & interactive online MIS for tracking progress on SDGs indicators (Visual display of SDGs information)

Coverage:


- i. 17 goals, around 388 indicators and 700+ schemes will be monitored




- Data availability for indicators at micro level
