Beyond Net-Zero

Accelerating our transition to a Climate, Nature, and Planet Positive Future

Following the <u>UNFCCC COP26</u> and the most recent <u>IPCC 2022 science report</u> on our climate crisis, more than 128 countries, cities, <u>5,000 companies</u> and more than <u>\$130tn</u> of capital are committed to <u>Net-Zero</u> carbon emissions by 2050. However, to be able to reach the Paris Agreement climate target of <1.5c, everyone in the world needs to be on that path today, which is currently not the case. In other words, we need to raise our ambitions at speed and scale, and go Beyond Net-Zero, to lead, innovate & inspire others to do the same. We need to incentivise business, finance and governments to do just that and this is our aim during the 50th Anniversary of the first UN Environment Summit at this year's Stockholm+50.

Until today, climate leaders have been without the roadmap, expertise and community required to go beyond Net-Zero. The POSITIVE SUMMIT will activate the Climate Positive movement, utilizing our collective strength and bringing everyone on the journey beyond Net-Zero. We will showcase how newly developed ITMOs will be a key part of achieving the Paris Agreement 1.5°C goal and present the best-in-class climate leaders from companies, cities, countries, and the financial sector.

As a Stockholm50+ side event, we will be launching the Climate Positive movement with high level stakeholders from business, finance, government leaders and innovators. This event will be a platform to redefine climate leadership across

Science Demands: The current IPCC report includes three main demands to achieve at least Net-Zero

- Net-Zero Now: Net-Zero targets require deep, rapid and far reaching transitions in all sectors now
- 2030 & 2050: World needs to halve its emissions by 2030 & reach Net-Zero emissions by 2050
- Carbon Removals: Massively scale carbon removals (100-1000 GtCO2e) this century

Market Drivers: The current market trends include three main drivers towards Net-Zero:

- Business Activism: >\$130tn of capital committed to Net-Zero. >\$39tn in divestment.
- **Regulation:** >\$33tn that is required by regulators (i.e. FCA) to disclose your carbon emissions
- Litigation: >1,950 cases against companies and countries not meeting science-based targets.

Market Demand: In order to meet the Paris Agreement 1.5c target we need the following to be met:

- Finance: We need \$75tn in finance to meet the Paris Agreement targets
- Carbon: Voluntary carbon was 0.2% of global carbon emissions. Nature can provide <u>23GtCO2e/yr</u>
- Nature: Can create \$10tn of economic opportunity per year by 2030

Themes: The POSITIVE SUMMIT is an exclusive event during Stockholm+50 where leading countries, cities, companies and citizens will kickstart a global movement and showcase their intentions, actions and ambitions to go Beyond Net-Zero and be positive towards our climate, nature and planet. The POSITIVE SUMMIT's objectives are to:

- Showcase Climate Positive pilot projects to demonstrate climate leadership and raise ambition.
- Exhibit the world's first ITMOs and explain how they will revolutionize carbon accounting.
- Educate and inspire citizens, companies, cities and countries to join this global Climate Positive movement.


